

E. FEELING AND DRAWING – START GAMES

E3 Three Decorations (Drawing creative patterns; pattern = repeated decorative design)

Skills practiced: fine motor skills; discerning visual differences, creativity

Needed: Make very simple sample of activity. Divide sheets of paper into three parts (fold?)

Items needed: Paper and pencils.

Activity: Participants design a pattern on each of the three parts of their sheet of paper. The pattern fills up the entire space.

Before beginning, possibly discuss with the students what different types of patterns they might make.



Each pattern should be totally different, preferably using a different drawing technique (dots; nice wrinkles or waves; lines).

If necessary, show the very simple sample prepared in advance.
